## Workhouse 2010 Accomplishments

- Closed the third floor for five months due to a reduced number of inmates.

- Continued to refurbish foreclosed homes with inmate labor to assist in providing affordable housing.

- Developed and implemented a weekend program for offenders. This provides an alternative the Bench uses for sentencing. This program increases revenue for the Workhouse.

- Nineteen Workhouse inmates received their GED.

- Refined the operational systems used for the successful boarding of offenders at Sherburne County, which helped reduce the impact on the Sheriff's transportation unit and jail, the Clerk of Courts, and the Community Corrections field and court services units.

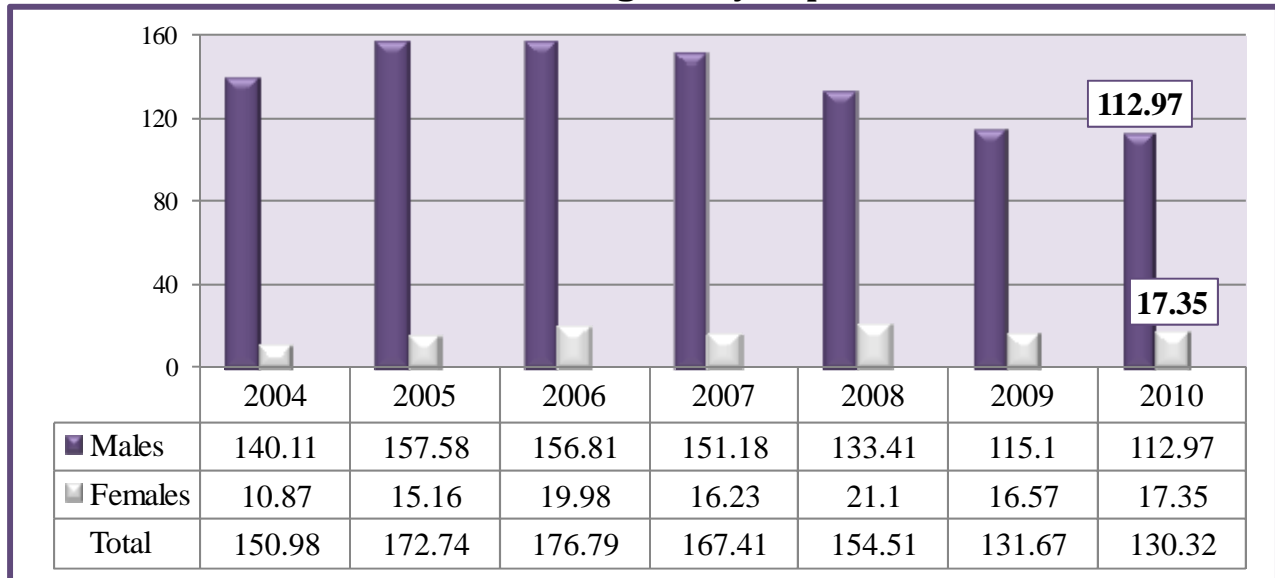
- Installed an upgrade to the PCI Jail Management System and trained all staff on this upgrade.

- Continued the ongoing process of training two of three new shift coordinators and one new assistant facility administrator.

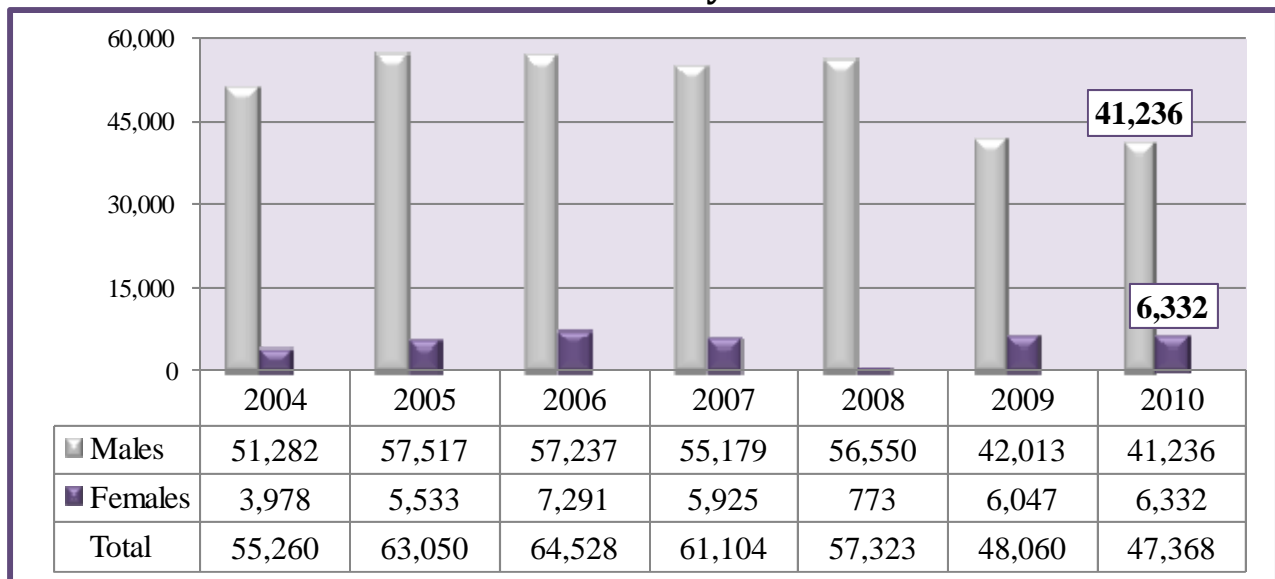
- Hosted and provided logistical support for the Human Services Leadership Training Program.

- Contracted with a new vendor for inmate phones, which offers more alternatives and increased revenue along with the capability to record conversations for law enforcement investigations.

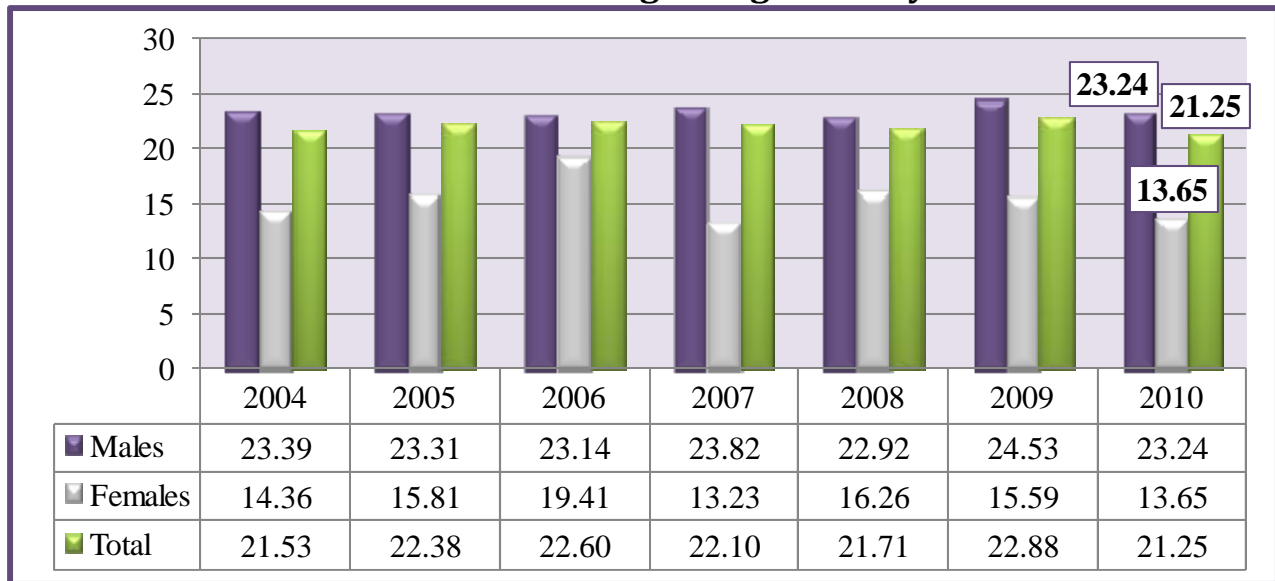
### Workhouse Average Daily Population



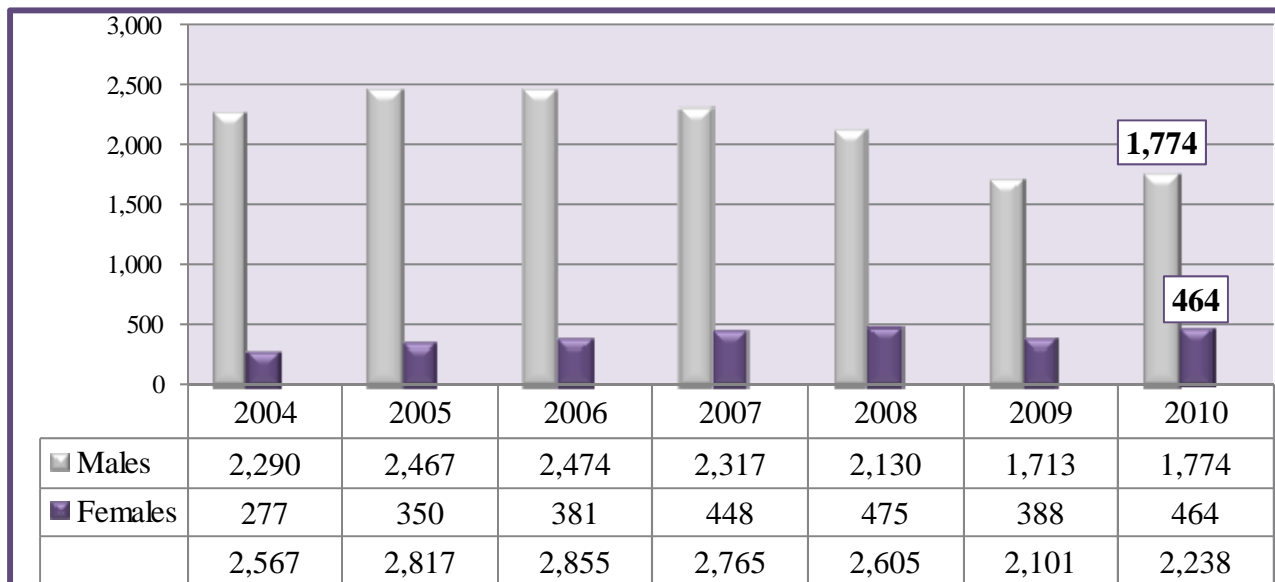
### Workhouse Total Days Confined



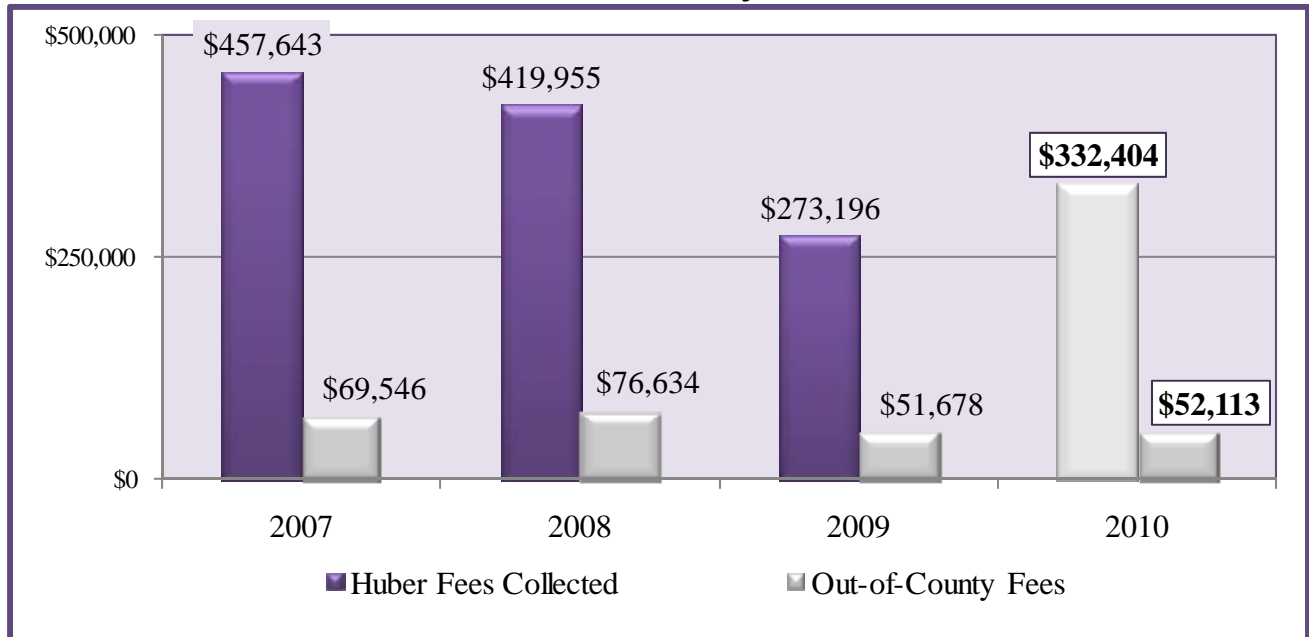
### Workhouse Average Length of Stay



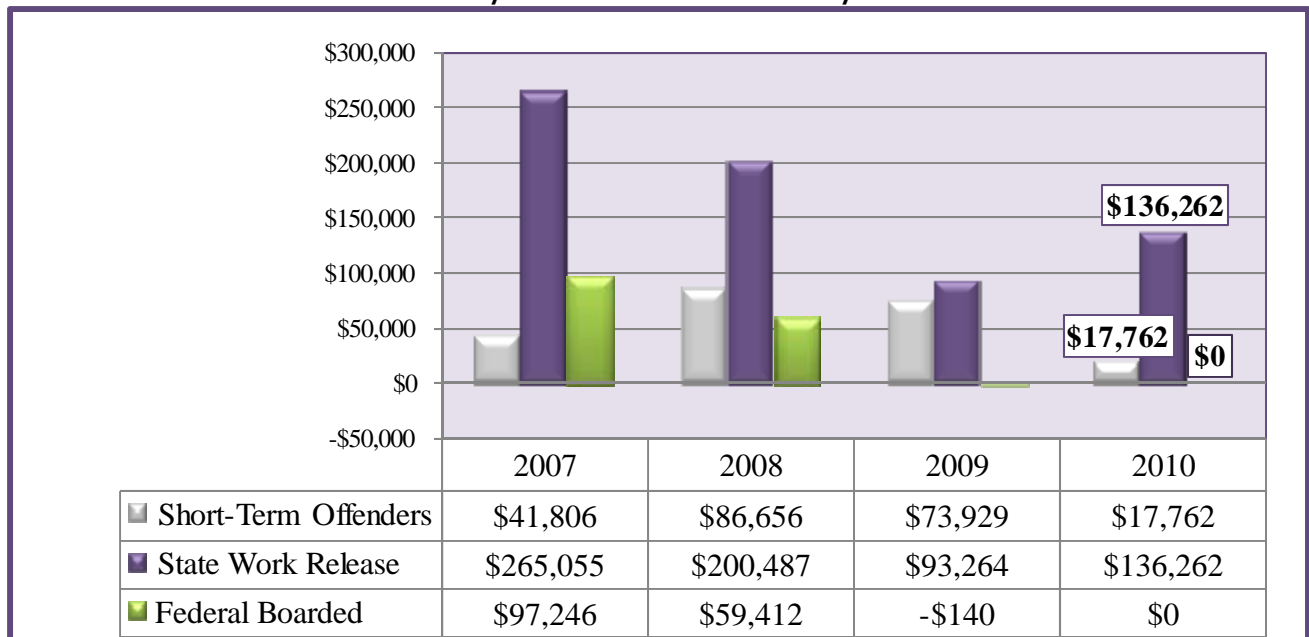
### Workhouse Intakes



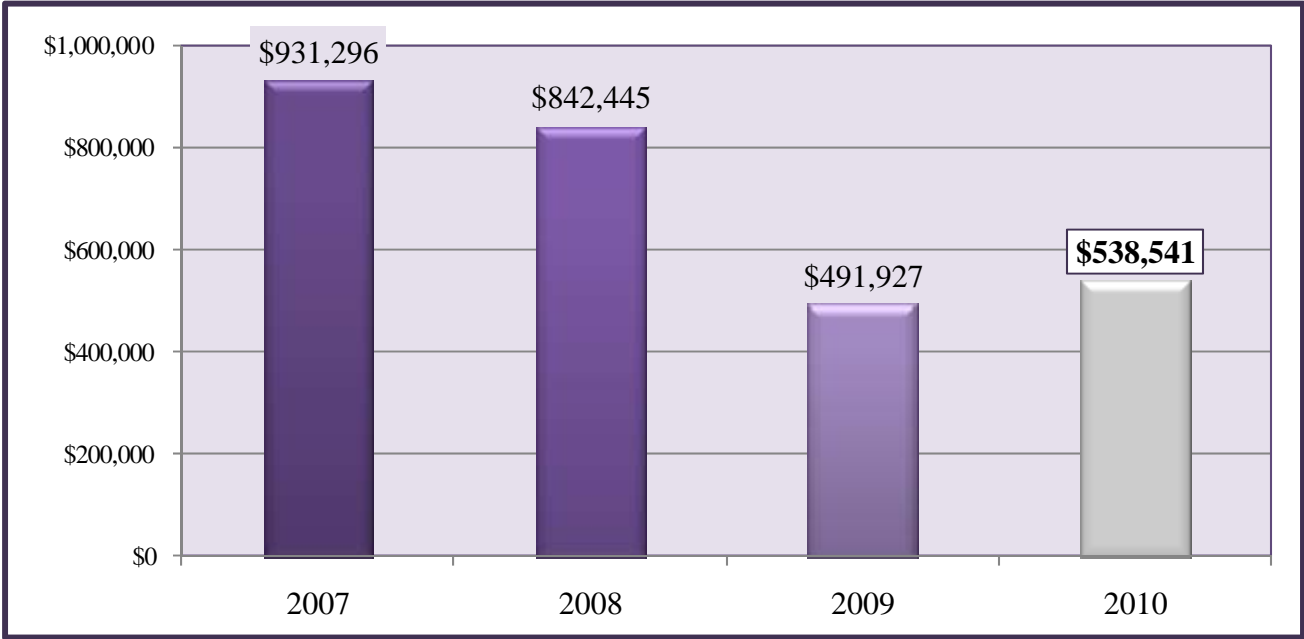
### Workhouse Fees Huber Fees and Out-of-County Fees Collected



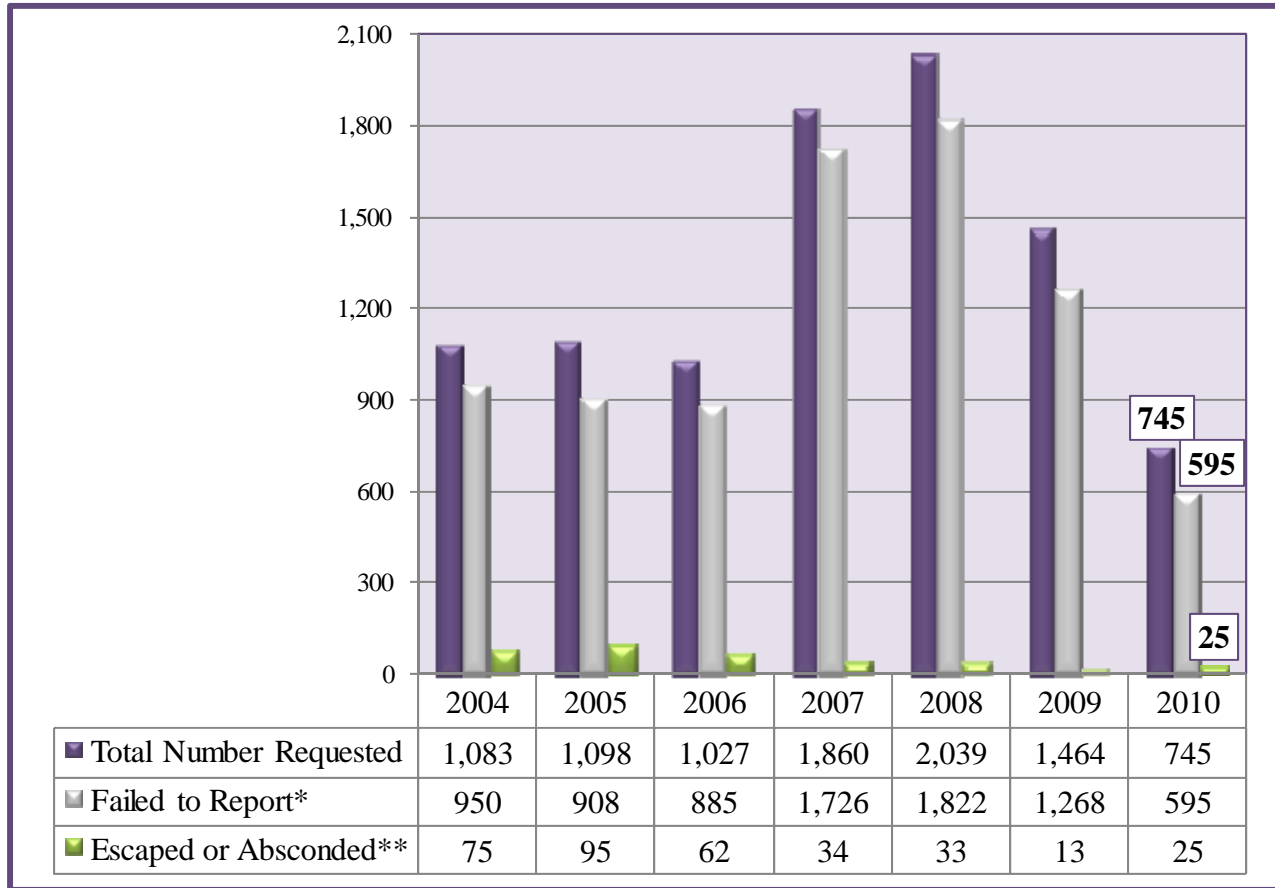
### Collected Fees for Short-Term Offenders/State Work Release/Federal Boarded

\* *Failed to Report:*

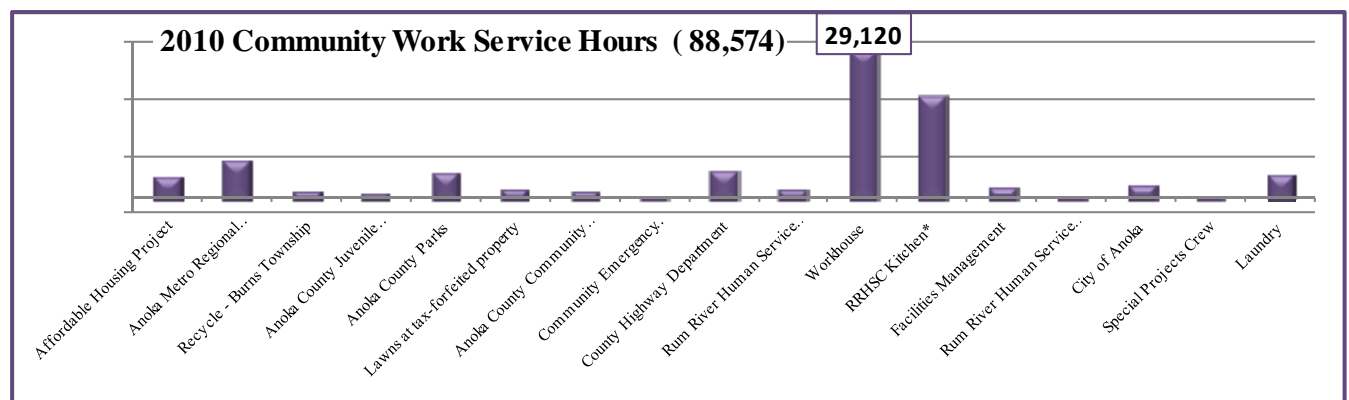
Refers to offenders who were given a report date for the Workhouse through the Court, but failed to show up at their assigned time and date, or completed a condition of probation.

Refers to inmates who did not complete their sentence because they left the facility or did not return from furloughs.

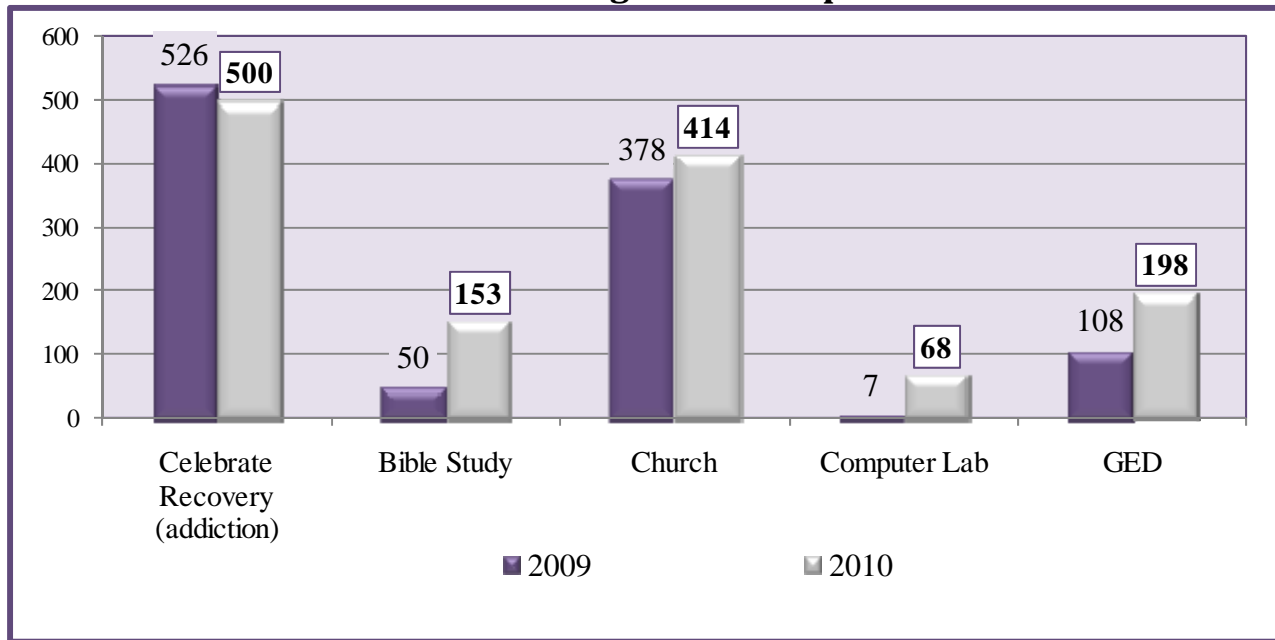

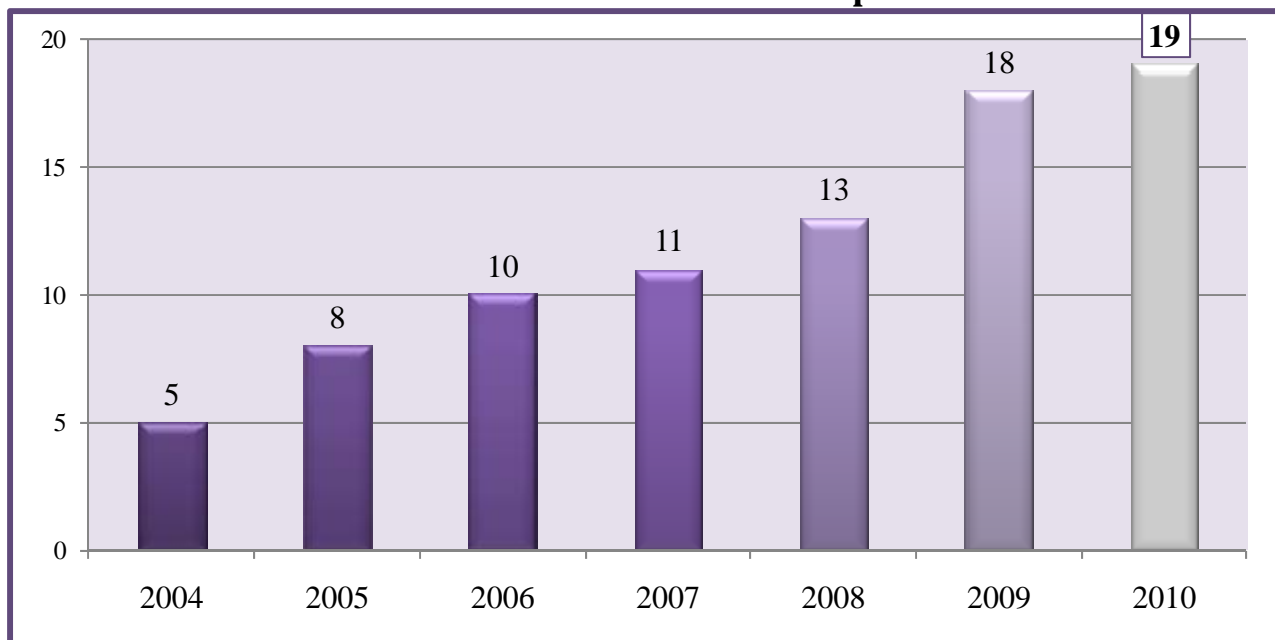

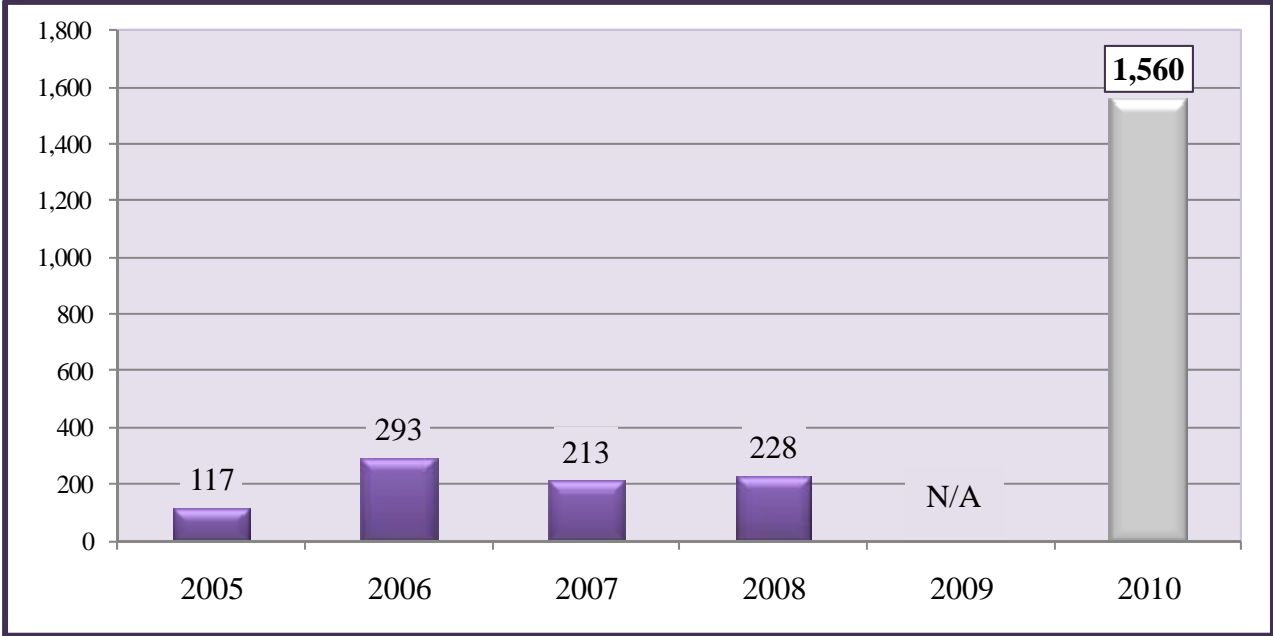

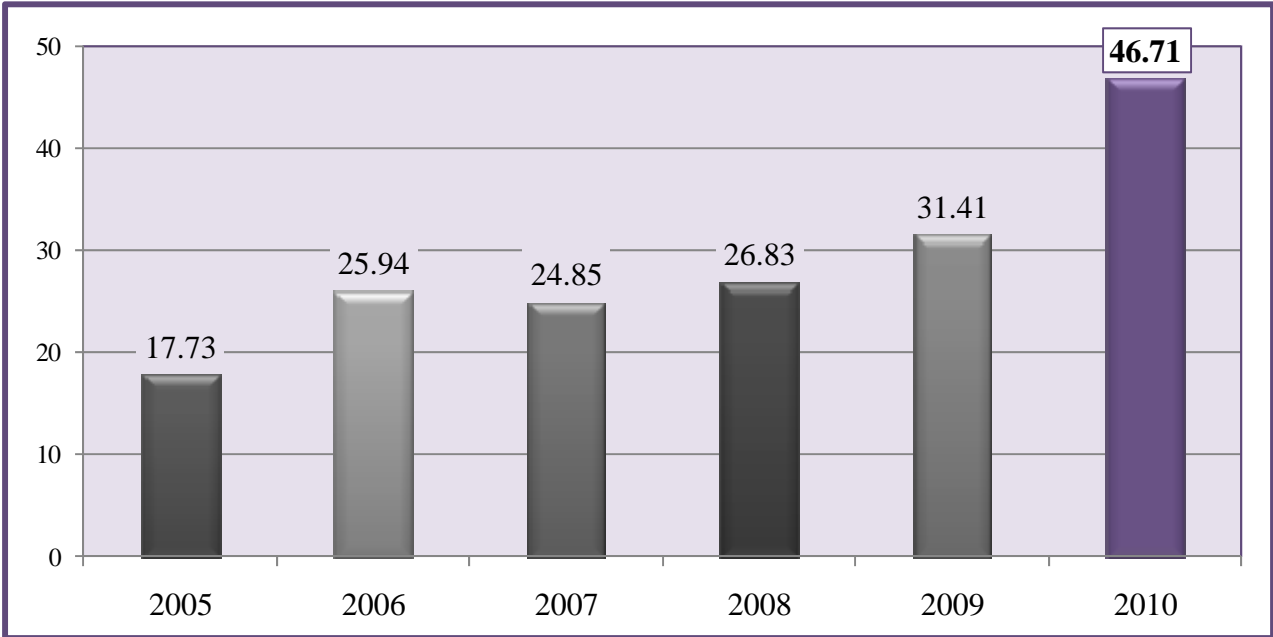
### Workhouse General Education Diplomas
