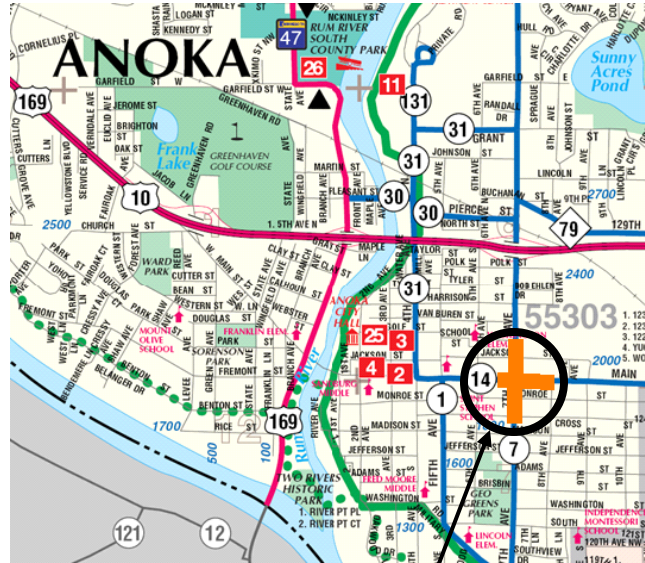


CSAH 7 (7th Ave) @ CSAH 14 (Main St.) Intersection Project

Where is the project?

The project is located at the intersection of CSAH 7 (7th Ave) and CSAH 14 (Main St.) in the City of Anoka. The project extends approximately 700 feet from the intersection for all four legs.



Project Location

Project Background:

The Anoka County Highway Department applied for and received a grant under the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) to add dedicated left turn lanes to the intersection at CSAH 7 (7th Avenue) and CSAH 14 (Main Street). The grant was awarded to Anoka County because of the number and the severity of crashes that were occurring at and near the intersection. The County and the City of Anoka are responsible for the construction costs not covered by the grant as well as design costs and costs to acquire property needed to complete the project. The project is scheduled for construction in 2012.

Project Background: What is being done?

The project includes several improvements. Key components of the project include:

- Adding left turn lanes on to CSAH 7 & CSAH 14
- Improving the pavement condition by milling and overlaying the existing roadway.
- Additional catch basins to improve drainage
