Monday, May 17, 2010	Minnesota Legislative Session ends
Tuesday, May 18, 2010	First day to file affidavits of candidacy for state and county offices and for cities and school districts with a primary
Tuesday, June 1, 2010	Last day to file affidavits of candidacy for state and county offices and for cities and school districts with a primary (until 5:00 p.m.)
Thursday, June 3, 2010	Last day to file affidavits of withdrawal for state and county offices and for cities and school districts with a primary (until 5:00 p.m.)
Friday, June 25, 2010	Begin in-person and mail absentee voting for State Primary Election
Tuesday, July 20, 2010	End of pre-registration of voters for State Primary Election (until 5:00 p.m.)
Friday, July 30, 2010	Pre-Primary Campaign Financial Report due
Tuesday, August 3, 2010	First day to file affidavits of candidacy for cities and school districts without a primary
Saturday, August 7, 2010	Absentee Voting – Extended hours: 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.
Monday, August 9, 2010	Absentee Voting – Extended hours: 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.
Tuesday, August 10, 2010	STATE PRIMARY ELECTION – polls open 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
Tuesday, August 17, 2010	Last day to file affidavits of candidacy for cities and school districts without a primary (until 5:00 p.m.)
Thursday, August 19, 2010	Last day to file affidavits of withdrawal for cities and school districts without a primary (until 5:00 p.m.)
Friday, September 17, 2010	Begin in-person and mail absentee voting for State General Election
Tuesday, October 12, 2010	End of pre-registration of voters for State General Election (until 5:00 p.m.)
Friday, October 22, 2010	Pre-General Election Campaign Financial Report due
Saturday, October 30, 2010	Absentee Voting – Extended hours: 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.
Monday, November 1, 2010	Absentee Voting – Extended hours: 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.
Tuesday, November 2, 2010	STATE GENERAL ELECTION – polls open 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
Thursday, December 2, 2010	Post-General Election Campaign Financial Report due
Monday, January 3, 2011	Terms begin for officials elected at November 2, 2010 General Election
